Luke 9:1-10 Jesus reached out to Zacchaeus.

Hebrews 10:24-25

²⁴ Let us think of ways to motivate one another to acts of love and good works. ²⁵ And let us not neglect our meeting together, as some people do, but encourage one another, especially now that the day of his return is drawing near.

1. SUPPORT AND ACCOUNTABILITY

James 5:16

¹⁶ Confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The earnest prayer of a righteous person has great power and produces wonderful results.

- We all need a Truth Teller in our life!

2. SPIRITUAL GROWTH

Proverbs 27:17 As iron sharpens iron, so a friend sharpens a friend.

- Your story helps others grow in their faith story!

3. FELLOWSHIP

Romans 15:5

⁵ May God, who gives this patience and encouragement, help you live in complete harmony with each other, as is fitting for followers of Christ Jesus.

- There is nothing more powerful than table ministry.

4. SERVING TOGETHER

Matthew 20:28

²⁸ For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve others and to give his life as a ransom for many.”

- Serving alongside others makes an eternal difference.

5. ENCOURAGEMENT

1 Thessalonians 5:11

So encourage each other and build each other up, just as you are already doing.

- To encourage someone means to give strength and validation.

Colossians 1:26-28

²⁷ For God wanted them to know that the riches and glory of Christ are for you Gentiles, too. And this is **the secret**: Christ lives in you. This gives you assurance of **sharing** his glory.²⁸ So we **tell others** about Christ, warning everyone and teaching everyone with all the wisdom God has given us. We want to present them to God, perfect in their relationship to Christ.
